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# State Government Sustainable Procurement Program – Services 2012-13

The ECO-Buy State Government Program provides expertise, advice and support to help enable state government entities meet their policy commitments in the area of sustainable procurement. Since the Program started in 2008-09, we have worked with more than 40 Government departments and agencies. The range of assistance provided has included:

- Capacity building via in-house workshops
- Tailored advice on greening tenders
- Reviewing sustainable product options in State Purchase Contracts
- Assessing spend and determining sustainable procurement priorities
- Design of sustainable procurement tracking and reporting models.

### How it works

Recognising that every organisation has its own strategic objectives and priorities, the service offerings are flexible and allow you to put together the most appropriate package of services to meet your particular requirements. This model has been developed based on extensive feedback from Victorian Government stakeholders. It is designed to suit organisations who may be starting out in sustainable procurement as well as those who are more advanced.

### What does the program comprise of?

#### **Base membership services**
